

# California Energy-Smart Homes Whole Building Alterations Photo Verification Form

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### 1 Instructions

Use this template to submit photos for verification of your whole building electrification alterations project for the Energy-Smart Homes program. The form below can be used for single family and multifamily low-rise alterations projects. Before and after pictures including photos of equipment name plates for every single appliance being replaced and installed are required. For multifamily low-rise projects, please submit 1 form per building of the property, following Photo Sampling Protocol shown in section 3.7.2 of the program handbook. Add, delete or re-size photo boxes and descriptions as necessary. Compressing the resolution of photos prior to inserting them into the template to make the file size more manageable may be necessary, however all nameplates and details demonstrating compliance must be clearly identifiable.

Prerequisite measures are listed below. Photos are only required for measures that are in the approved Energy-Smart Homes scope of work. Measures that are not applicable to the project can be left blank or deleted.

To add a photo, click the picture icon within the desired photo box. Choose 'from a file' and select the photo you wish to insert. For multifamily low-rise projects that need to submit additional photos to meet sampling requirements, simply highlight existing photo boxes then copy and paste into empty space below. Please be sure to label any additional photos.

When you have completed this form, upload to the <u>participant portal</u> and notify your assigned operations associate.

# 2 Heat Pump Space Heating (HVAC)

Instructions: Determine if you are upgrading to a ductless or ducted heat pump. If you are upgrading to a mix of both, you only need to provide before photos once. HVAC installations require photos of both the outdoor and all indoor units installed. Central Heat Pump installation requires photos of the old central AC system and the gas furnace being removed. Photos of data plates will be required for these appliances being removed as well.


